

Rolled Slip Stitch Cowl

Pattern

Base

- CO 128 sts
 - R1: K all sts
 - R2: *K1, Sl1* repeat to end of round
 - R3: K all sts
 - R4: *Sl1, K1* repeat to end of round
 - R5: K all sts
 - R6: *K1, Sl1* repeat to end of round
 - R7: K all sts
 - R8: *Sl1, K1* repeat to end of round
 - R9: K all sts
 - R10: *K1, Sl1* repeat to end of round
 - R11: K all sts
 - R12: *Sl1, K1* repeat to end of round
- #### **Set up for decreases**
- R13: K6 [PM, K15] 3x, PM, K26, [PM, K15] 3x, PM, K6
- #### **Decreases**
- R14: [*K1, Sl1* to marker, SM, K2tog, *K1, Sl1* repeat to marker, SM, Sl2tog, *Sl1, K1* to marker, SM, K2tog] repeat to last marker, then knit in pattern (K1, Sl1) to end of round
 - R15: K all sts (*Note: after the 2nd, 4th, 6th, 8th marker the S2tog stitches should be knit together*)
 - R16: *Sl1, K1* repeat to end of round
 - R17: K all sts
 - R18: *K1, Sl1* repeat to end of round
 - R19: K all sts
 - R20: [*Sl1, K1* to marker, SM, Sl2tog, *Sl1, K1* repeat to marker, SM, K2tog, *K1, Sl1* to marker, SM, Sl2tog] repeat to last marker, then knit in pattern (Sl1, K1) to end of round
 - R21: K all sts (*Note: after the 1st, 3rd, 5th, 7th marker the S2tog stitches should be knit together*)
 - R22: *K1, Sl1* repeat to end of round
 - R23: K all sts
 - R24: *Sl1, K1* repeat to end of round
 - R25: K all sts
 - R26: [*K1, Sl1* to marker, SM, K2tog, *K1, Sl1* repeat to marker, SM, Sl2tog, *Sl1, K1* to marker, SM, K2tog] repeat to last marker, then knit in pattern (K1, Sl1) to end of round

- R27: K all sts (*Note: after the 2nd, 4th, 6th, 8th marker the S2tog stitches should be knit together*)
- R28: *Sl1, K1* repeat to end of round
- R29: K all sts

Body

- R30: *K1, Sl1* repeat to end of round
- R31: K all sts
- R32: *Sl1, K1* repeat to end of round
- R33: K all sts
- Repeat R30-33 until piece measures 9" long (unrolled)

Finishing

- BO Knitwise
- Weave in ends

Abbreviations

- CO – Cast on
- K – Knit
- P – Purl
- Sl – Slip stitch
- K2tog – Knit two together
- Sl2tog – Slip two together
- PM – Place marker
- SM – Slip marker
- BO – Bind off

About

It's literally freezing outside so I decided to lock myself in my house until I knit something that would protect my neck and face from frost bite once I'm forced to go back outside. This Rolled Slip Stitch Cowl has rolled edges so it can be rolled down and worn just around the neck; or you can unroll the top so that it wraps around your ears and mouth acting as a cozy windshield.
